Car travel

Parking is available on the John Radcliffe site but the car parks are often very busy after 9:30am on weekdays. The most convenient way of reaching the hospital is by Park and Ride. The main P&R is a new service from Water Eaton. Details of this and other options are inside this leaflet.

If driving to the hospital by car, follow signs for Oxford then the "H"/"A&E" and "Hospitals" signs. You'll be directed via the A40 northern by-pass, and B5150 (Marsh Lane), or via Headington on the A420 London Road. These routes take you to the B4495 (Headley Way). The approach road to the John Radcliffe is on Headley Way.

From the site of the old Radcliffe Infirmary take the Woodstock Road north for 1 mile, then right (Moreton Road) following the "H" and "A&E" and John Radcliffe signs, along Marston Ferry Road to Headley Way.

Car parking

There are four main parking areas for patients and visitors:

- Car Park 1:** For Trauma Unit, Cardiac Services and Main Hospital
 - Car Parks 2 & 2A:** For Main Hospital and Women's Centre
 - Car Park 3:** For West Wing and Children's Hospital
 - Car Park 4:** For parents and carers of children with appointments at the Children's Hospital
- Parking is "Pay on Foot" - pay at machine as you return to your car, not at the barriers. Change given.

There are places to pick up and set down patients at the main entrances.

Parking for "blue badge holders" is available in Car Parks 1, 2, 3, and 4 (charges apply) and opposite the Level 2 entrance to the Main Hospital, West Wing/Children's Hospital entrances and Maternity entrance to Women's Centre (free of charge). See hospital plan.

How to find us

Local buses and Park & Ride

The hospital is served well by buses, both to the hospital itself and to nearby Headington and there is a park and ride, the 700, direct to the hospital from Water Eaton. Routes and times for the main services Monday to Friday are summarised inside this leaflet.

On foot or bicycle – the healthy option

The hospital is within 10 minutes walk of Headington Centre. It has entrances onto Osler Road, Sandfield Road and Saxon Way as well as Headley Way, the main entrance. This makes access easy from all directions. A map of Oxford's cycle network is available from the County Council, www.oxfordshire.gov.uk Footways and cycle paths to the site are shown on the map inside. Cycle parking is available in several locations at the hospital, some of it undercover, see plan.

From further afield

By train

The John Radcliffe is about 3 miles from Oxford railway station, with its frequent trains from London (Paddington) and many other parts of the UK. Allow 15 to 20 minutes by taxi from the station forecourt and 25 to 30 minutes by bus number 13 and 14 direct to the hospital.

By coach

The "Oxford Express" (X90) and the Oxford Tube operate frequently 24 hours a day to and from central London, stopping in Headington Centre, 10 minutes walk.

By air

Oxford is well placed for airports in London and Birmingham. London Heathrow is about 70 minutes by bus – **Airline Express X70**. There is also an **Airline Express X80**, to London Gatwick. These services stop in Headington Centre.

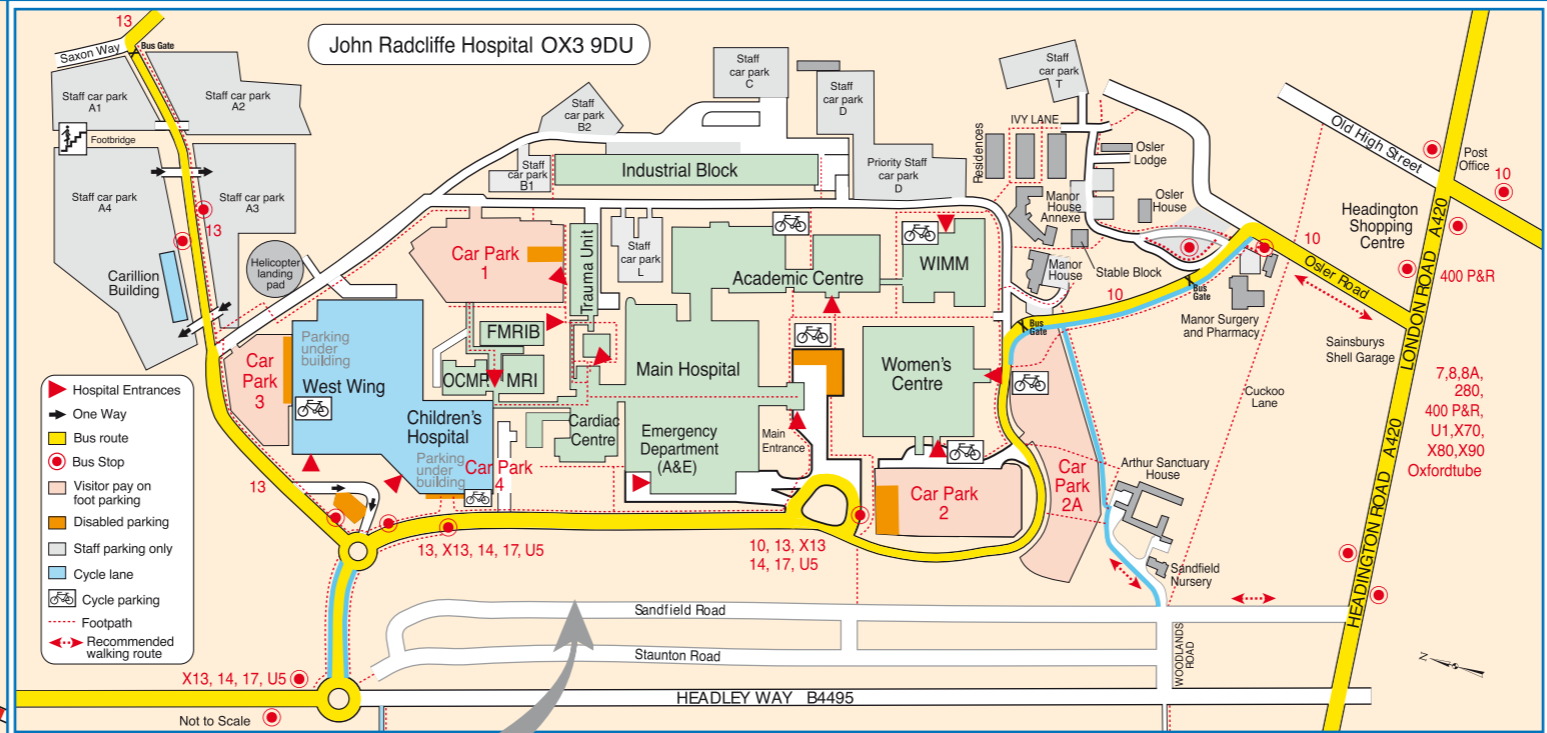

About the John Radcliffe Hospital

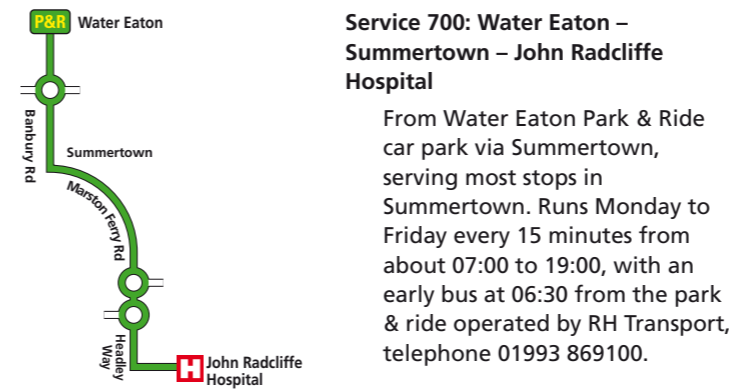

Buses direct to the hospital

- 10** Cowley Road – Cowley Centre – Hollow Way – Slade – Wood Farm – Headington Centre - JR
Runs every 12 to 15 minutes each way, from about 06:00 to 18:45. **Operated by Stagecoach Oxfordshire**
Parts of the route is supplemented by service **U5**
In the evenings the **U10** service covers a similar route every hour, each way. **Operated by Stagecoach Oxfordshire**
- 13** Rail Station – City (St Aldates then High St.) – Marston-Northway – JR
Runs every 20 minutes each way, from about 06:00 to 23:00. **Operated by Oxford Bus Company**
- X13** Abingdon – A34 – Abingdon Road – City (St. Aldates then High Street) – Marston – JR
Runs every 20 minutes between 05:40 and 23:15. **Operated by Oxford Bus Company**
- 14& 14A** Railway Station, City Centre (George Street and Debenhams) – Banbury Road (south end of Summertown) - Marston
Runs every 30 minutes each way from about 06:00 to 18:20. **Operated by Stagecoach Oxfordshire**
In the evenings the **17** service covers the route every hour each way. **Operated by Stagecoach Oxfordshire**
- U5** Cowley Road – Cowley – Slade – Girlestone Road – Gipsy Lane – Marston Rd. – JR
Runs about every 30 minutes term time between 08:15 and 19:00. In evenings, service **U10** covers the route. **Operated by Stagecoach Oxfordshire**

Buses that stop in Headington, 8 minutes walk via Osler Road or Sandfield Road

- 7& 7C** Kidlington – Summertown – City Centre – Headington – Barton
Runs every 15 minutes between Kidlington and Barton and every 6 to 7 minutes between City and Barton
Operated by Stagecoach Oxfordshire
- 8& 8A** City Centre – Headington – Barton/Risinghurst
Runs from about 05:00 to 23:00.
Between 07:00 and 19:00 buses are every 6 to 7 minutes.
Operated by Oxford Bus Company
- 400** Thornhill (Eastern) P&R – Headington – City Centre – Rail Station – Seacourt (Western) P&R
Runs every 15 minutes from about 07:00 to 19:00.
Operated by Oxford Bus Company
- 280** Aylesbury, Thame, Wheatley – Headington – City Centre – Rail Station
Runs every 30 minutes from about 07:00 to 19:00 and 60 minutes in evenings. **Operated by Arriva**
- U1** Wheatley Campus, Wheatley – Headington – City – Botley – Harcourt Hill Campus
